This interactive workshop presents information regarding the impact of trauma to children and provides a neurodevelopmental framework in the process of completing the assessments required, to create a Positive Behavior Support plan. The information can and has been used to develop plans for adults as well as children.

Case examples are used to apply theory to real world situations and participants are invited to present their own case studies in the class. Attendees are not required to be certified in or use The Mandt System in their organizations.

The training is appropriate for all staff at all levels of the organization. A background in psychology or medicine is not required! It is highly recommended that organizations send as many people as possible to this workshop in order to work together in groups to transfer theory into practice using specific case examples from their organization.

1. Demonstrate an awareness of the impact of trauma on human neurodevelopment
2. Describe the impact of trauma on the developing brain and neural networks
3. Demonstrate an awareness of the effect of stress on cognitive and affective reasoning
4. Describe the basic functions of human behavior
5. List the primary emotions people feel under stress
6. Apply the principles of trauma, neurodevelopmental processes, and positive behavior support in specific cases
